## 2012 The Confluence Cabernet Merlot

### Vineyard

This wine is from the spectacular 'Inglewood' Vineyard located in the upper reaches of the Hunter Valley. The name 'Two Rivers' was drawn from the Vineyard's unique position nestled on the banks of the Hunter River near its confluence with the Goulburn.

### Region

100% Hunter Valley

60% Cabernet Sauvignon 40% Merlot

**Alc/Vol** – 13.1% v/v

### Tasting Notes

The 2011 Cabernet Merlot is a richly balanced wine that displays deep aromas of cassis and blackcurrant that carry seamlessly through to the palate. Fine tannins and spicy French oak give the palate a soft lingering finish.

### Winemaking

After harvesting the juice was left for 24 hours to cold soak, then left on skins for 7 days. Fermentation was carried out on skins for 7 days while keeping the temperature between 18°C and 25°C. This wine was then matured in selected oak barrels for 12 months.
