DENMAN'S Two Rivers vineyard scooped the pool at last week's Cowra Wine Show, bringing home eight medals, four of them gold.

The Cowra Wine Show is in its 29th year and is one of the largest national wine shows in the country.

This year's competition attracted 2100 entries.

Two Rivers won top gold and best verdelho of the show for its 2011 Hidden Hive Verdelho, top gold for its 2010 Stones Throw Semillon, top gold for its 2009 Rocky Crossing Cabernet Sauvignon and gold for the 2011 Stones Throw Semillon.

The vineyard also took out four bronze medals.

General manager Mr Keeping said he was delighted to see a number of wines place so highly, but he was particularly pleased with the success of the verdelho.
